In reply to your letter (undated) I have to state no official report of any description has been received concerning No. 1838 Private F.S. Gore, 42nd Battalion. It is pointed out however, that cases of minor disability, not likely to develop seriously, are not reported by cable message, the official intimation of same being contained in hospital lists received by post which take some time in reaching this office. Should his condition have at any time presented serious symptoms, a cabled report would have been despatched to this office for transmission to next-of-kin, shown as father, resident at Willoughby, North Sydney.
